RESOLUTION #011-2012

A RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT NON-MOTORIZED TRAILERS PARKED ON VILLAGE STREETS

Whereas, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Tiltonsville, that prohibiting parking of non-motorized trailers on village streets is in the best interests of the Village:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TILONSVILLE, COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: To add new paragraph C to Chapter 76 of the Ohio Basic Code that states "It is illegal to leave non-motorized trailers parked on village streets for a period not to exceed 48 hours".

Section 2: The provisions of this chapter shall not be deemed as supplemental to any authority existing by virtue of the statutes of the State, or any ordinance heretofore enacted by Village Council.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force upon the earliest period allowed by law.
